PWC Statement on Alcohol

In general, hosts are usually not liable unless:

- Alcohol is served to a minor.
- The host was irresponsible in serving alcohol as <u>they should have known or did know that the guest was intoxicated</u>, so he/she should have stopped serving alcohol.

What you should do as a host:

- <u>Don't drink too much as the host.</u>
- Make sure no minors are served,
- If possible, host at a restaurant or bar as they are the ones that can monitor and be liable.
- Discourage your guests from drinking excessively and stop serving them.
- <u>Have a policy about guests drinking too much</u> (required to call taxi, etc.) so guests know what will happen if they become intoxicated.
- At each gathering <u>consider having a designated driver</u> who does not drink. That person could help get people home. People could take turns being the designated driver.
