

# Find My iPhone/iPad


- Set your device

- Tap the switch to enable it.





# Find My iPhone/iPad

  - Log into your **iCloud account**.
  - Click on **Find iPhone** in the main menu.
  - Enter your **Apple ID and password** and sign in if prompted
  - Click on **All Devices** at the top.

- Use AppleID Family Sharing features
  - See all members in Find My iPhone
  - All family purchases on all device
  - One Apple Music membership for all users
  - Only one bill
  - Shared photo albums

# Bonus - AppleID

- Setup Family Sharing

- Go to Settings > [your name].
- Tap Set Up Family Sharing, then tap Get Started.
- Confirm that you want to be the family organizer and that you're signed in with your personal Apple ID.
- Follow the onscreen instructions



# Printing From My iPhone/iPad

- Requires you have a printer that support AirPrint! (most “recent” printers)
- Printer must be network connected (wired or Wi-Fi)
  - Open the app you want to print from.
  - To find the print option, tap app's share icon, or , or tap . ...
  - Tap or Print.
  - Tap Select Printer and choose an AirPrint-enabled printer.
  - Choose the number of copies or other options, like which pages you want to print.
  - Tap Print in the upper-right corner.



- Launch the Settings app from the Home screen of your iPhone or iPad.
- Now tap on General.
- Scroll all the way to the bottom and tap on Reset.
- Tap on Erase All Content and Settings.
- Tap on Erase iPhone.
- Tap on Erase iPhone again to confirm.
- Enter your Passcode.


