- Cambridge Analytica used a quiz at called This Is Your Digital Life
- App advertised on Amazon
- Participants were paid \$5 to participate but users had to have a Facebook account
- Information harvested for respondents AND their friends
- 320,000 Facebook users with around 87 million friends
- Individuals linked to electoral records were targeted with highly personal political advertising

 Facebook has begun notify users who were affected We understand the importance of keeping your data safe.


We have banned the app "This Is Your Digital Life," which one of your friends used Facebook to log into. We did this because the app may have misused some of your Facebook information by sharing it with a company called Cambridge Analytica. In most cases, the information was limited to public profile, Page likes, birthday, and current city.


You can learn more about what happened and how you can remove apps and websites anytime if you no longer want them to have access to your Facebook information.


There is more work to do, but we are committed to confronting abuse and to putting you in control of your privacy.



Let's Talk About Cybersecurity

- Security is the belief that a system will behave as intended
 - ▶ The right message will get to
 - ► The right person at
 - ► The right place at
 - ▶ The right time
- ▶ A secure system does no more or less than intended.
- TRUST is a assessment of the system's likely behavior
- If you are using a digital product that you didn't pay for, YOU are the product

The Cyberworld Is A Dangerous Place, Just Like The Physical World

- Yes Facebook knows things about you
- Yes Your bank knows things about you
- Yes Your phone company knows things about you
- Yes Your cable company knows things about you
- Yes Your doctor knows things about you

Yes - all this data is stored electronically and almost certainly accessible from anywhere in the world

No, You Are Not Safe If

- ▶ No You are not safe if you have a router
- No You are not safe if you don't have Wi-Fi
- ▶ No You are not safe if you just do email
- No You are not safe if you only have a Mac
- No You are not safe if you don't use Twitter

No, you aren't always safe in the Cyberworld, just like you aren't always safe in the physical world

Cybersecurity Is All About Cost, Benefit, Risk Tradeoffs

Cost - money and effort you are willing to invest?

Benefit - the value of connectivity and maintaining communication, contacts, and conveniences

Risk - what's really at risk?

The World In 2018

- ► The most popular password worldwide was "12345". The second most popular was "password"
- ▶ 7 out of 10 organizations say their cybersecurity risk increased in 2017
- ▶ 54% of companies experienced at least one successful attack that compromised data and/or IT infrastructure in 2017
- > 77% of attacks in 2017 utilized exploits (broken software) or "fileless" techniques
- ▶ 69% of organizations no longer believe their antivirus alone can stop the threats they are seeing
- 4 out of 5 organizations replaced or augmented their existing antivirus solution in 2017
- Only 33% of organizations believe they have adequate resources to manage cybersecurity effectively
- Worldwide cybersecurity spending will reach \$96 Billion in 2018
- The total cost of a successful cyber attack is over \$5 million (average \$301/employee)

Trends For 2018

- Attacks are evolving to incorporate fileless techniques
- Antivirus solutions are being replaced or supplemented
- Security is getting more expensive and difficult to manage
- Ransomware is on a steep decline while cryptomining malware booms
- Internet of Things (IoT) will be Massive in 2018 (11 Billion connected devices)
- The "S" in IoT stands for Security
- Using data to "control" the opinions of human targets is on the rise
 - ▶ 60% of Americans get news from social media
 - ▶ 30% say social media is their ONLY source for news


That's Depressing - What Can I Do?

- Remember, some information really is personal
- ▶ Don't rush. Assess the situation. Think before you Click.
- ▶ Use good passwords. "BoilerUp" may not be your best choice.
 - ▶ Password keepers are good but the Master Password must be REALLY good.
 - Dashlane, Sticky Password Premium, Keeper Password Manager and Digital Vault, LogMeOnce (https://www.pcmag.com/article2/0,2817,2407168,00.asp)
- Use good sources of information (PCMag, Cnet, Macworld, 9to5Mac)
- Use only trusted Wi-Fi sources. Free isn't always free!!

That's Depressing - What Can I Do?

- KEEP BACKUPS!! (at least 3 copies)
 - On your machine
 - Somewhere else in your house (USB Drive)
 - ▶ In the cloud (OneDrive, iCloud, GoogleDrive, AmazonDrive, Carbonite, Mozy)
- Good machine security package (aka AntiVirus)
 - ▶ Free ones are good
 - ► For money versions are better with more fileless protection schemes (Norton, McAfee, Webroot)
 - ▶ Be sure to use the update service/subscription at least once a month. Once a week is better


Honestly, The War Is Over

- Provides for encryption, digital signatures, attachments, and metadata






- Subset of Postscript page description programming language

- A structure to bundle all elements into a single file with data compression options for easy transport




Adobe Acrobat



The Short History of Voice Control

- Launched in 2011, Apple's Siri was the first voice activated technology to hit the streets in 2011 on iOS5 with the launch of the iPhone 4S.
- The following year saw search giant Google follow suit with Google Now on its range of Android 4.1 (Jellybean) phones. only to be replaced with Google Assistant which first launched in Spring 2016 with the Google Home.
- The most established of these is Amazon's digital assistant, Alexa, which made its debut in November 2014, and has since branched out from Amazon's own hardware into a number of third-party devices like the C by GE Sol, Amazon Fire smart TVs and the Logitech Harmony Hub.
