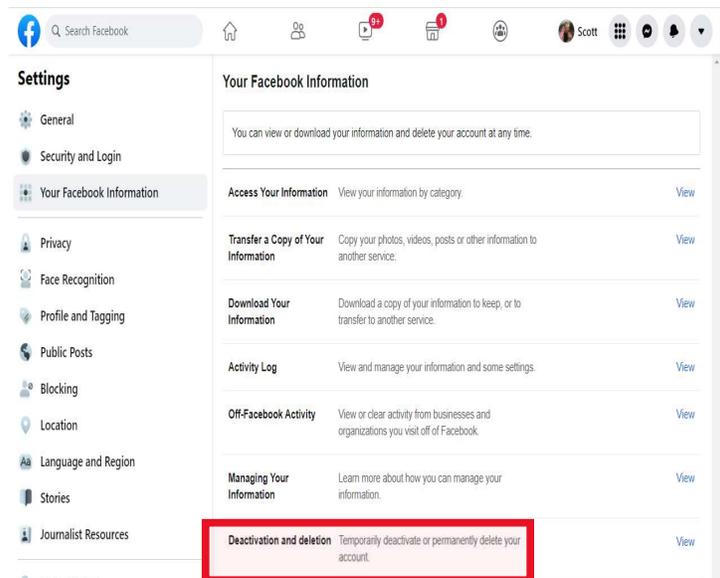

# Facebook

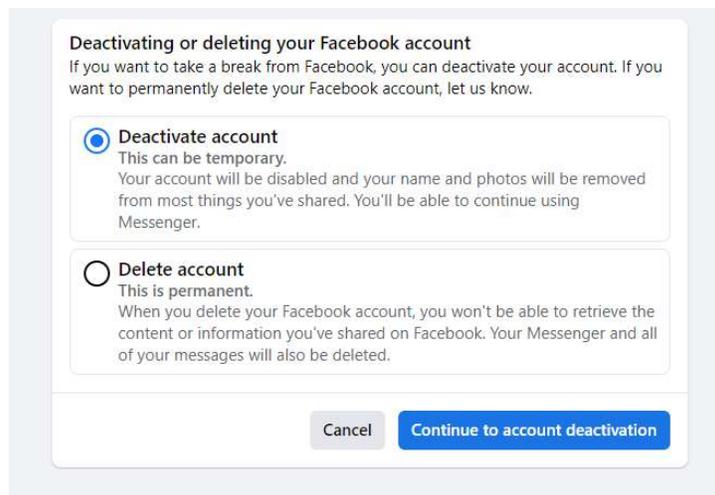
- Deactivate does NOT delete
- Settings, Your Facebook Information
- Deactivation and deletion

# Facebook

- Select desired action
- Yes, it is just a REQUEST
- Facebook delays action for “a few days”
- A subsequent login during this period will CANCEL your request
- Delete the app from your device and don't visit
- Download first if you don't want to lose your data

# Instagram

- You can not delete your account via the app. You must use the Web User Interface (WebUI)
- Click person icon in the top right corner
- Go to Settings
- At the bottom, there is an option to “temporarily disable the account”
- To permanently delete

## TikTok

---

- In the app, click on Profile on the bottom left
- Pull down the menu ☰
- Click on Manage Account
- Then Delete account
- Option to download data if needed
- Confirm choice
- Data is deleted in 30 days

## Twitter

---

- Just erase old Tweets, 3<sup>rd</sup> party app TweetDelete will handle this
- To download your archive, click on Profile
- Settings and privacy
- Your account
- Download an archive of your data (optional)
- Deactivate your account
- Data is deletion will begin 30 days after the reactivation period.
- Actual deletion can take "a few weeks"

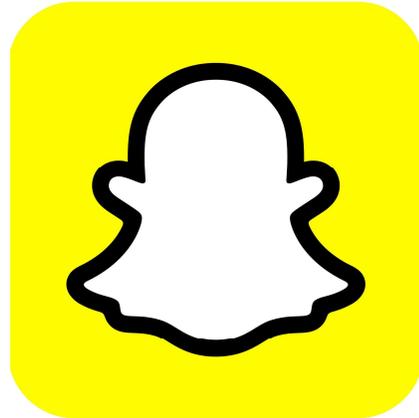

## Snapchat

---

- Delete not available in the app
- Visit Snapchat Account Portal and login
- Account is deactivated for 30 days
- Deletion begins at the end of the deactivation period

## WhatsApp

---

- In the app, click Settings
- Account
- Confirm your phone number
- Delete My Account
- No reactivation later

## Reddit

---

- To delete posts before deactivation, see FAQs on the app
- Deactivate is permanent
- Account Setting
- Deactivate Account
- Scroll to Connected Accounts
- Disconnect accounts

---

- Go to “Me” section
- Settings and Privacy
- Account
- Account Management
- Close your LinkedIn Account

## Pinterest

- Click on 3 dots in upper right corner
- Edit Settings
- Deactivate account
- Select a reason
- Permanently close my account
- You will need to respond to a verification email to finalize the delete
